COV-ID 19 Restrictions & Information– (07/08/20) We are open **to Daily/Weekend Campers, under the guidance of NYS & The Columbia County Health Department. Our First Priority** is the Health and Safety of our **Guests & Staff.** (Updates will be provided, as necessary. All recommendations will be adjusted as necessary)

**All CDC's recommendations and NY executive orders must be followed.**

- **No social gatherings Larger than 25.**
- **No more than a TOTAL of 25 Persons Per site.**
- **Social Distancing of 6' and Masks are required in Public Spaces if distancing is not possible.**
- **All common gathering spaces are closed.**
- **We cannot accept Tent sites at this time.**
- **Advanced Reservations Required.** Fully Self-Contained Units Only.
- **All bathing facilities are closed.**
- **ALL Children/Minors under 18, Must be Supervised and remain with Parent or Guardian AT ALL TIMES.**
- **FOR EVERYONE'S safety, we ask that you stay at your campsite, as much as possible - or only where needed to go in the campground. Please limit riding around the campground on golf carts and bicycles.**
- **No Congregating in groups larger than 25.**

1. Masks must be worn when six feet of separation cannot be maintained. If it is only PEOPLE YOU LIVE WITH, Masks don't need to be worn. If you have your friends or neighbors visit you must wear masks. It does not matter if you know them or trust them or think its non-sense you have to wear a mask when you are not 6 feet apart.

2. When in public spaces like the store you must wear a mask.

3. Your children are your responsibility, they will not wear masks or social distance when you are not watching them. This is why children under the age of 18 are not allowed off your site without a parent. \*A responsible adult means "someone who is legally responsible for your child's welfare".

4. Masks must be worn when on your golf cart if it is not solely family members from the same house. If you are friends or neighbors or don't live in the same house you need to wear a mask.

Children under 18 with a license can drive golf carts but must have a parent with them.

5. **The beach:** masks are required when you are not 6 feet apart unless you live in the same house. You do not need a mask while you are swimming. Campers must come to the office to get swim bracelets before arriving at beach.

**\*\*Compliance with this is mandatory.** Random checks by staff, and government officials will be conducted. Anyone not in compliance will be removed from the camp. Our ability to remain open relies on us following the guidelines, we have been warned. If you need clarification on any of the issues please contact the office.

**CHECK IN** We ask our Daily/Weekend Campers to Ring the Call Button at the Entrance Gate and come to the store for Check in if there is not a gate attendant.

**OFFICE/CAMP STORE** will be open to walk in services, The Store will be open 9 AM-6 PM Monday-Saturday & 9am – 5pm Sunday

**GATE CARDS** will made available for weekend campers. We charge a returnable \$ 10.00 Deposit. If you will need to leave the campground during your stay, please plan accordingly.

**PROPANE FILL TIMES** Daily 10 AM & 5PM. Please pay for and drop off your tanks at the designated Drop off location prior to fill time. Propane tanks will be available for pick up 10:30 AM & 5:30 PM Daily at the designated pick up Location.

**VISITORS** Registered Campers may have DAY/Overnight VISITORS. Visitors must register in the office from 9AM-6PM Daily. Visitors will not be accepted after 6 PM. All Day Visitors must depart by 9PM. Visitors may not currently use the beach.

**This is official notice that you are being notified that New York State REQUIRES a 14-day Quarantine if you are arriving from Alabama, Arizona, Florida, North Carolina, South Carolina, Texas, Utah, Georgia, Iowa, Idaho, Louisiana, Mississippi, Nevada, Tennessee, Arkansas and California.**

Quarantine Requirements from DOH:

- The individual must not be in public or otherwise leave the quarters that they have identified as suitable for their quarantine.
- The individual must be situated in separate quarters with a separate bathroom facility for each individual or family group. Access to a sink with soap, water, and paper towels is necessary. Cleaning supplies (e.g. household cleaning wipes, bleach) must be provided in any shared bathroom.
- The individual must have a way to self-quarantine from household members as soon as fever or other symptoms develop, in a separate room(s) with a separate door. Given that an exposed person might become ill while sleeping, the exposed person must sleep in a separate bedroom from household members.
- Food must be delivered to the person's quarters.
- Quarters must have a supply of face masks for individuals to put on if they become symptomatic.
- Garbage must be bagged and left outside for routine pick up. Special handling is not required.
- A system for temperature and symptom monitoring must be implemented to provide assessment in-place for the quarantined persons in their separate quarters.
- Nearby medical facilities must be notified, if the individual begins to experience more than mild symptoms and may require medical assistance.
- The quarters must be secure against unauthorized access.
- I also understand that compliance is my responsibility.
